Site operator reserves the right to accept or reject any debris brought to the area. Transfer station rules and regulations will be enforced to the full extent of the law and violators will be prosecuted.

All cardboard boxes, newspapers, tin cans, clear glass and colored or cloudy plastic containers (non-brittle) are to be recycled.

A separate container has been installed for all metals except any products that contain refrigerant such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers.

Acceptable Electronic Waste

Televisions, monitors, terminals, computers, scanners, ink cartridges, printers, fax machines, coffee pots, toasters.

Residential Construction Projects

For home renovations, roof replacements, or major construction projects, South Bristol residents will need to hire a commercial disposal company to place a dumpster at their construction site.

Contractors are not allowed to use the Town construction debris (CD) site.

Resident and construction debris user passes are available for purchase at the Town Clerk's Office on Tuesday and Thursday 9:00 am to 4:00 pm and Saturday 9:00 am to 12:00 pm.

Residents will be allowed a "trunk load" (18 cubic feet or 3 x 3 x 2) at no charge.

CD Site Not Acceptable Items

Asbestos waste
Bottles
Cans
Foul wastes
Hazardous or industrial wastes (partially filled paint cans, etc.)
Plastic bags, refuse or garbage
Roofing materials
Rubber products (tires/tubes)
Septic tank liquid
Shingles
